What is the Kingdom About?

Many of us spend all kinds of time and energy trying to uncover the treasure that will make our life worth living. We search here and there to find the pearl of great price and we never seem to find it.

Some think that money will satisfy all the hopes and dreams of the human heart. Others think their lives will be satisfied by becoming powerful, making their authority felt, impressing others with their superior skill and knowledge. Many think that happiness is found in the satisfaction of every physical desire. But these appetites are never satisfied.

Like the great King Solomon we should not ask for a long, soft, easy life or for riches, power or superficial pleasures. Our prayer should be for understanding, wisdom and hope so that we might value what is right, true, good, lasting, excellent and beautiful.

The parables of the Kingdom of Heaven call us to a deeper faith, a greater hope and a stronger love so that the Kingdom might become a reality in our day. Both the "buried treasure" and the "pearl of great price" are the value placed on the Kingdom, on what and who deserves it either human or divine. What is the Kingdom all about? It is about all the people of our world - young and old, rich and poor, saint and sinner. It is about their well-being, their happiness. It is all about the fullness of life for all of God's creation. Jesus has come to bring the fullness of life for all of us.

All during the Lord's days on earth, He went about doing good: healing the lame, giving sight to the blind, opening up the ears of the deaf, raising the dead to life. He was a friend of sinners, the poor, widows and orphans, all the people of everyday life. He always had time for others and showed his compassion, mercy and love to them. Jesus was a life giver - not a life taker - and that is what the Kingdom of God is all about.

The Kingdom is about life issues, greater human justice and social equality, honesty, fidelity and daily bread for all. It is about human dignity and human rights, better family life, greater care and concern for our children, friends, immigrants, refugees and senior citizens. It is about peace and an end to all the violence that we see in our troubled world. It is about a healthy human life for each and every one of us; a clean environment, green grass and clear lakes and streams.

When we talk about the Kingdom, it is a matter of putting first things first - making Jesus Lord of our lives day in and day out. We are to value the Kingdom as our first and very best work. May our God grant us the wisdom and insight to find life's true riches and recognize them as the "pearl of great price," selling all that we have for the Kingdom.
