Petition Drive to Preserve Marriage in Maryland: May 12/13 & May 19/20 After Masses

The Catholic Church in Maryland is working to repeal legislation passed by the General Assembly to drastically redefine marriage in Maryland. You must be registered to vote to sign the petition. Your name must be printed as it appears on your voter registration. Bring voter registration card to petition drive, or visit <http://www.mdelections.umd.edu/voter-registration/status/> to see how you're registered. Register to vote now! It could take 2-3 weeks for the Board of Elections to verify registration. You must be an American citizen, a Maryland resident, and at least 18 years old by the general election to vote. For Your Information

The State of Maryland passed a law to permit same sex couples to marry. Maryland does not offer civil unions to same sex couples. The primary difference between marriage and civil unions - apart from societal meaning attached to those terms - is that marriage confers numerous federal benefits and protections on U.S. citizens. These include Social Security survivor benefits, sick leave to care for an ailing spouse, tax breaks, veteran's benefits, family discounts, family medical insurance through employers, spousal visitation in the hospital and making medical decisions for a spouse who is unable to do so. Civil unions protect a portion of these rights, but not all of them. Maryland currently permits unmarried opposite sex couples and same sex couples to register as domestic partners. Domestic partners are granted limited rights, including hospital visitation, making funeral arrangements and adding a partner to a property deed without incurring transfer tax liability.
